## About the Moshal Scholarship Program

The **Moshal Scholarship Program** operates in **South Africa and Israel**. Its goal is to support **highly motivated and resilient students** from financially disadvantaged backgrounds to complete university degrees and improve their futures and communities.

The program currently supports **around 1,000 students** and has funded **1,173 graduates** to date, many of whom completed demanding degrees.

## Fields of Study Covered (2026)

Scholarships are awarded for **degree studies** in **STEM and Commerce** fields at selected universities.

## What the Scholarship Covers

The Moshal Scholarship provides **full financial and developmental support**, including:

- Full tuition fees
- Living and meal allowance
- Laptop allowance
- Personal support from a Program Coordinator
- Professional mentoring
- Career guidance and employer engagement
- Professional workshops and training
- Access to a strong student and alumni community

Shortlisted applicants may be invited for an **interview**. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified via **email**.

## Eligibility Requirements

Applicants **must meet all requirements** below:

- Be in **Matric** or have completed Matric
- Intend to study or be studying toward an eligible **degree in 2026**
- Be accepted or studying at one of the following universities:
  - Nelson Mandela University (NMU)

- Rhodes University (RU)
- Stellenbosch University (SUN)
- University of Cape Town (UCT)
- University of the Free State (UFS)
- University of Johannesburg (UJ)
- University of KwaZulu-Natal (UKZN)
- University of Pretoria (UP)
- University of the Western Cape (UWC)
- University of the Witwatersrand (WITS)
- Achieve **at least 70%** in:
  - English
  - Mathematics
  - Physical Science and/or Accounting
- Come from a household with a **family income of R200,000 or less per year (before deductions)**

## How to Apply

Applications must be submitted **online**:

**Moshal Scholarship Application 2026**

Steps:

1. Create an online account
2. Complete the application form
3. Enter “**www.zabursaries.co.za**” when asked how you heard about the scholarship
4. Upload all required documents

## Required Supporting Documents

(All documents are compulsory)

- South African ID copy
- Passport and study visa (if not SA citizen)
- Parents'/guardians' ID copies
- Signed Declaration/Consent Form (if under 18)
- Proof of income:
  - Social grant letter/statement **OR**
  - 3 months' bank statements from all parent/guardian accounts **OR**
  - Affidavit stating no bank account

- Grade 11 November results

## Additional Documents for Shortlisted Candidates

- Matric final results (if in Matric)
- Latest university transcript (if currently studying)
- Proof of university acceptance/provisional acceptance
- NBT results (if available)
- Proof of application for other funding
- Parents'/guardians' payslips

## Important Notes

- Applications can be **saved and completed later**
- Once submitted, **no changes can be made**
- Incomplete applications may be **disqualified**

Late applications will **not** be accepted.
